DEPARTMENTS

ENGLISH

During the three years of junior high English classes, the students have moved through a functional language-arts program. The basic skills emphasized were reading, writing, speaking, listening, spelling and studying.

Classroom projects included letters, stories, autobiographies and essays. Students bought hundreds of paperbacks. They read such books as *Call of the Wind*, *Huckleberry Finn* and *Little Women*, and made oral or written reports. Some students made dioramas instead of the usual book reports.

In addition to the regular class work, many students entered spelling, poetry, vocabulary, grammar, essay and speech contests. Several students were responsible for publishing the school paper, "Junior Hi-Lights," and the yearbook, JUNIOR HIGH REVIEW, under the sponsorship of Mrs. Nead.

Mrs. Nead's speech classes have given daily announcements, weekly devotional and patriotic programs and convocations. One of Mrs. Poole's classes was responsible for announcements and programs in Building B.

Eighth and ninth graders went to the Reading Center, where Mrs. Bilby was in charge of a Developmental Reading Program. Speed and comprehension increased, and a significant growth in vocabulary appeared.

English classes were taught by Miss Throckmorton, Mrs. Janulis, Mrs. Poole, Miss Wilt, Mrs. Nead, Mrs. Williams, Mr. Daggy, Mrs. Jantsch, Mr. Scott, Mr. Lottes, Mrs. Hunter, Mr. Milton Wallace and Mrs. Rickert.

MATHEMATICS

The goal of instruction at the junior high level is to provide a learning program adapted into adolescence.

The primary objectives are: (1) to develop the ability to use mathematical processes with an insight into their value; (2) to provide experiences which will give the child the ability to apply his knowledge in the affairs of daily life.

Teachers of mathematics are Mr. Daggy, Mr. K. Wallace, Mr. Niflis, Mr. Bowers, Mr. Garner, Miss Wilt, Mrs. Saint, Mr. Wanley, Mr. Pasman, Mr. King and Miss Rupley, Mrs. Sherrill and Miss Smith, department head.

SCIENCE

The mad scientists have completed another year without sending any students into orbit. Our young scientists have been engaged in many activities other than the regular classroom routine. Mr. Williams' students have been trying to out-argue their teacher and Mr. Bookout has been working with several eighth graders in his after-school lab. Mrs. Day has provided a number of fascinating field trips for her students. She has also helped Mr. King with the Science Club. This active organization has waded through the caves at Spring Mill State Park, probed the mine dumps near Terre Haute for plant fossils, learned about the natural history of Shades State Park, with the resident naturalist, and visited Cincinnati's museums and parks.

SOCIAL STUDIES

Courses are offered in geography, Indiana and United States History, Problems of Democracy and World History.

The Wide Wide World Club, under the sponsorship of Mr. Frazier, has had a most enjoyable and profitable year. There were 115 members this year in the

The Student Council election was conducted by Mr. Maxwell's ninth grade classes.

Several interesting programs were presented during the year by different classes in the department. Mrs. Culp's second period class presented one on the Constitution, Mr. Morris' fourth period class did the United Nations Day program and Mr. Tague's second period class gave the Columbus Day program. The February bulletin board in Building A was done by Mr. Meyer's and Mr. Tague's classes.

Social studies classes were taught by Mrs. Sherrill, Mr. Marks, Mr. Frazier, Mr. Wiles, Mr. P. Morris, Mr. Meyer, Mr. Maxwell, Miss Rupley, Mr. Tague and Mrs. Culp, department chairman.

ART

A variety of projects have been experienced this year by art students under the instruction of Mr. Clair Smith. Highlights of the program were units on collage, mosaics, water color, stained glass window mosaics, commercial art, drawing in all media such as pencil, ink, charcoal, and chalk drawings. The students especially enjoyed a unit on figure drawing.

Mr. Smith supervised the JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL REVIEW Cover Design Contest. From over 150 entries from grades seven, eight and nine, Terrie Whitted was selected as the winner. Honorable mention went to Lynn Murray, Larry Flynn, Janice Griner, Jill Lough and Dennis Overton.

Jill Lough received a certificate of merit for her entry in the L. S. Ayres Scholastic Art Awards Contest. Jill entered a fashion design.

The art classes were responsible for the lovely Christmas bulletin boards in the main hall. Other projects included posters for the "Christmas Sing-Along" Concert, the "Faculty Basketball Game" and the "Showboat."

The seventh grade art classes were under the supervision of Mrs. Dickerson and Mrs. Garner this year. The pupils worked in many areas — drawings including cartoons, still life, portraits, scenery, animals and non-objective; mosaic constructions of grains, glass, paper and wood; paper sculpture; lettering, and posters.

Medias with which the pupils worked included pencil, ink, India ink, crayons, water color, charcoal and a combination of these medias.

Famous artists were studied and examples of their works were shown. Also, pupils displayed home projects and hobbies as a means of cultivating interest.

Pupils used their talents well and found art class to be fun and rewarding.

Lynn Murray received two honor awards this school year. She placed second in the JUNIOR HIGH REVIEW Cover Design Contest. She also received a certificate of merit in the regional show of the National Scholastic Art Awards contest for her water color and ink drawing of a cat.

CRAFTS

Pupils in Mr. Albrecht's craft classes explore and make many projects from a wide variety of materials, such as metals, wood, reed, ceramics, mosaics and plaster.

Many decorative and useful objects are made while each pupil is encouraged to develop his own ideas and initiative in handwork.

EXPLORATORY LANGUAGE

For the third time, Exploratory Language has been

Latin and Spanish before planning their ninth grade schedule.

For nine weeks, three days a week, either Spanish has been studied, with Mrs. Tabares as teacher, or Latin has been studied, with Miss Hodson as teacher. The second nine weeks, these teachers traded classes so that the students spent an equal amount of time in the study of the two foreign languages.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

The Spanish and Latin classes of the ninth grade have taken up their first foreign language study for high school credit. The group work in both languages has involved learning vocabulary and translating sentences.

The five Latin classes have been taught by Miss Hodson. The work has included practice in pronunciation, reading and writing Latin, learning about our Roman heritage, learning about English words derived from Latin, and the daily life of the Roman people. A chapter of the Junior Classical League was organized with a total membership of 95 students.

There have been six Spanish classes, four taught by Mrs. Williams and two taught by Mrs. Tabares. These classes have a good foundation in Spanish history as well as in writing and speaking Spanish words. They have begun to realize that a knowledge of this language is beneficial in our relationship with our Spanish-speaking neighbors of the Western hemisphere.

Early in May a merit scholarship examination was given in both Latin and Spanish with recognition for winners being made on Honor Day.

HEALTH AND PERSONAL LIVING

Techniques of group guidance were used first semester to assist the individual to achieve better understanding of self and others, to plan for high school and to make vocational studies. Personality and vocational interest tests were taken by the students.

Mental health, body systems and functions, anatomy, nutrition, diseases, health services, safety and first aid, narcotics and alcohol were topics covered in the second semester. Self-responsibility for following wholesome health practices receives emphasis.

Teachers in this department are Mr. Bookout, Mr. Judd, Mr. Marks, Mrs. Miller, Mrs. Day and Mr. Taylor Morris.

MUSIC

School wouldn't be school without our music program, and this year courses in this field included band, orchestra and choir. Each group had participants entered in solo and ensemble competition, of which several were first place winners in the state contest.

Several eighth and ninth grade bandmen participated in the second band camp at McCormack's Creek Park for a week of marching, playing and recreation.

Mr. Bogue directed eighth and ninth grade choir and the junior high school string orchestra. Miss Collins has been our seventh grade choir director. Mr. Houston has taught cadet band and woodwind class. Mr. Brahmstedt directs the junior high school band and brass and percussion class.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Physical education has been taught to both boys and girls this year in the seventh and eighth grades.

These students have participated in many activities including tumbling, gymnastics, volleyball, basketball, square dancing, rhythms and kickball. Wrestling was included in the curriculum this year. We also

not only developed healthier bodies, but learned the meaning of coordination in working together in teams, as well as individually.

Instructors were Miss Fleming and Mr. Wegesin.

PRINTING

Ninth grade boys, under the supervision of Mr. Beguhn, are enabled to delve into the graphic arts (printing) and a few of the varied opportunities available to them.

Divided into four areas, this course includes block cutting, book binding, silk screen and hand composition.

Having this background material enables a student to elect to continue his work in the graphic arts — one area in a vast number of related fields. Further training is obtained in the vocational printing trades class, open to juniors and seniors.

GENERAL SHOP

The general shop is best characterized by the broad scope and variety of experience it offers to junior high school boys taking industrial arts for the first time.

Being cognizant of the fact that the basic objective of industrial arts is to interpret industrial occupations and the products of industry, Mr. Giles and Mr. Jett each spend one semester with each boy in the seventh grade. Because students have a natural desire to investigate, experiment and construct articles, this objective can be accomplished through the construction of useful projects involving pupil planning and individual and group activity.

Industrial arts is certainly a part of general education. It derives its content from industry — a basic element of our culture — and further, it has as its social purpose, a greater understanding and better control of the phenomena of industry.

INDUSTRIAL ARTS

This course specializes in the study of the changes in the form of materials to make them more useful to man's needs. Taught by Mr. Locke in Building A, students learn correct use of tools, the careful selection and handling of materials and the constructive cooperation of working with others.

HOMEMAKING

Girls who took classes in homemaking learned much about the art of sewing and cooking. Classes in this department were offered to seventh and ninth grade girls. In the sewing classes, girls enjoyed making and designing skirts, blouses and shorts. Good grooming was studied. A style show was held in May.

In foods classes, proper nutrition was studied. Students planned, prepared and served various meals. "Open House" was observed in each class at Christmas and at Easter seasons. Cookies and punch were usually served and the students made these.

LIBRARIES

Both Buildings A and B have centralized libraries that are ready to serve students and teachers with materials for the various departments in the school curriculums as well as recreational reading and browsing.

Here in junior high we wish to extend to all students the opportunity for them to learn how to use library facilities to enrich and supplement their class work and individual interests. Teacher librarians, Mrs. Noble and Mrs. Grimm in Building B, and Mrs. Scheetz in Building A are always ready to help stud-

DEPARTMENTS

Student helpers (known as Library Cadets in Building A) come from their study halls to help with many routine duties, such as checking out books, shelving returned materials, re-enforcing magazines, decorating bulletin boards, filing, etc. Their own work comes before any of these duties, but they all manage to help some each hour.

Our teacher-librarians are continually selecting and ordering materials to meet the needs of our school curriculums and to provide an opportunity for additional exploration and discovery for individuals, teachers as well as students.

GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING

The guidance and counseling department serves every student from the time he enters the seventh grade until he leaves the junior high school to become a high school sophomore.

If a student needs help with personal problems, class adjustment or future plans, he visits the office of Mrs. Saint in the seventh grade, Mr. Lehr in the eighth grade or Miss Modlin in the ninth grade. With these counselors, each student individually plans his subjects for the following year. In preparation for high school, group meetings and individual conferences are arranged with the students and parents to present the entire high school course of study and to aid in the selection of the curriculum to be followed.

Mr. Corbin has charge of attendance in the seventh grade and sponsors the student council. In the

eighth and ninth grades Mr. Lehr, Miss Modlin and Mrs. Hunter co-sponsor the student council.

HEALTH SERVICE

Efficient nursing services are rendered by nurses in junior high school. Mrs. Bailey serves in Building A and Mrs. Klein in Building B. Immediate attention is administered to sudden illnesses and accidents occurring at school. If a student needs more than first aid or temporary care, parents are notified so they can call for the child and assume further care. Only in an emergency or when parents cannot be located, is the student taken home or to the family physician.

Early in the year, hearing tests are given to seventh grade pupils and new students of all three grades by the speech and hearing therapists, Mrs. Spitler and Mr. Wilson. They also give speech therapy to those who need or wish help.

All eighth grade students and new students in ninth grade are given health interviews. This includes a vision screening test. Tuberculin testing is offered later in the year.

Dr. Fisher, the school physician, does medical examinations on students called to his attention by the school nurse. If necessary, parents are then notified of the child's health problem. Through the services of the family doctor, the child then secures the need treatment and/or correction.

It is hoped by these services the children will become better students.

Here in the New Castle Junior High School inter-scholastic athletic program, two new sports were added. The boys now participate in cross country track, football, basketball, wrestling and track.

Winning games and meets is our goal. Still, we are trying to teach the fundamentals of each sport and make it possible for the boys to win berths on the high school varsity teams. Therefore, we usually have a larger number of boys participating in practice than is necessary to make up the teams. We feel this is necessary in order not to overlook boys who may develop into good future players.

We award letters in each of our six sports to those boys in the eighth and ninth grades whom we feel are deserving of them. The boys in the seventh grade receive blue ribbons. 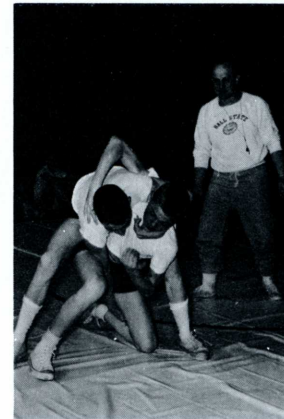
During the school year of 1962 and 1963 the Junior High School boys participated in 12 football games, 5 cross country track meets, 76 basketball

The track coaches are Milton Wallace and William Williams, ninth grade; Robert Wiles and Kenneth Wallace, eighth grade. Cecil Tague is the ninth grade cross country track coach; William Williams is the eighth grade and ninth grade wrestling coach.

Acting as a co-ordinator of the athletic program is John Maxwell, Athletic Director. His work is making all schedules, issuing and caring for all equipment, scheduling buses for out-of-town trips, checking scholarship of boys participating in the program, securing referees and other officials needed for all home games.
