# Full Sessions Begin Tuesday, September 7

## School Calendar For the Year Is Announced

Friday, September 3, is The Day!

That's when the legions of New Castle and Henry Township youngsters trek back to school rooms for the 1954-55 school year.

Then on the following Tuesday, September 7 — the day after Labor Day — classes really start and the semester is on in earnest.

On Friday at 8:25 a.m., the elementary school children report to their various buildings to enroll and pay book rental fees.

Kindergarten children report at 9 a.m. or 1 p.m., depending on when they are enrolled, for registration; they should have with them their birth certificates and be ready to remit fees.

Junior and Senior High School students go Friday, Sept. 3, from 8:25 a.m. until 11 a.m.; and from 1 p.m. until 2:50 p.m.

### CLASSES START TUESDAY, SEPT. 7

Full sessions of classes will start Tuesday, Sept. 7, for all — elementary, junior and senior high school — students in the city and township.

The schedules were announced Tuesday by Hexford G. Wright, superintendent of city-township schools. The schedule for the county school system in the other townships, as well as the teachers, were announced last week by T. Don Edington, county superintendent.
