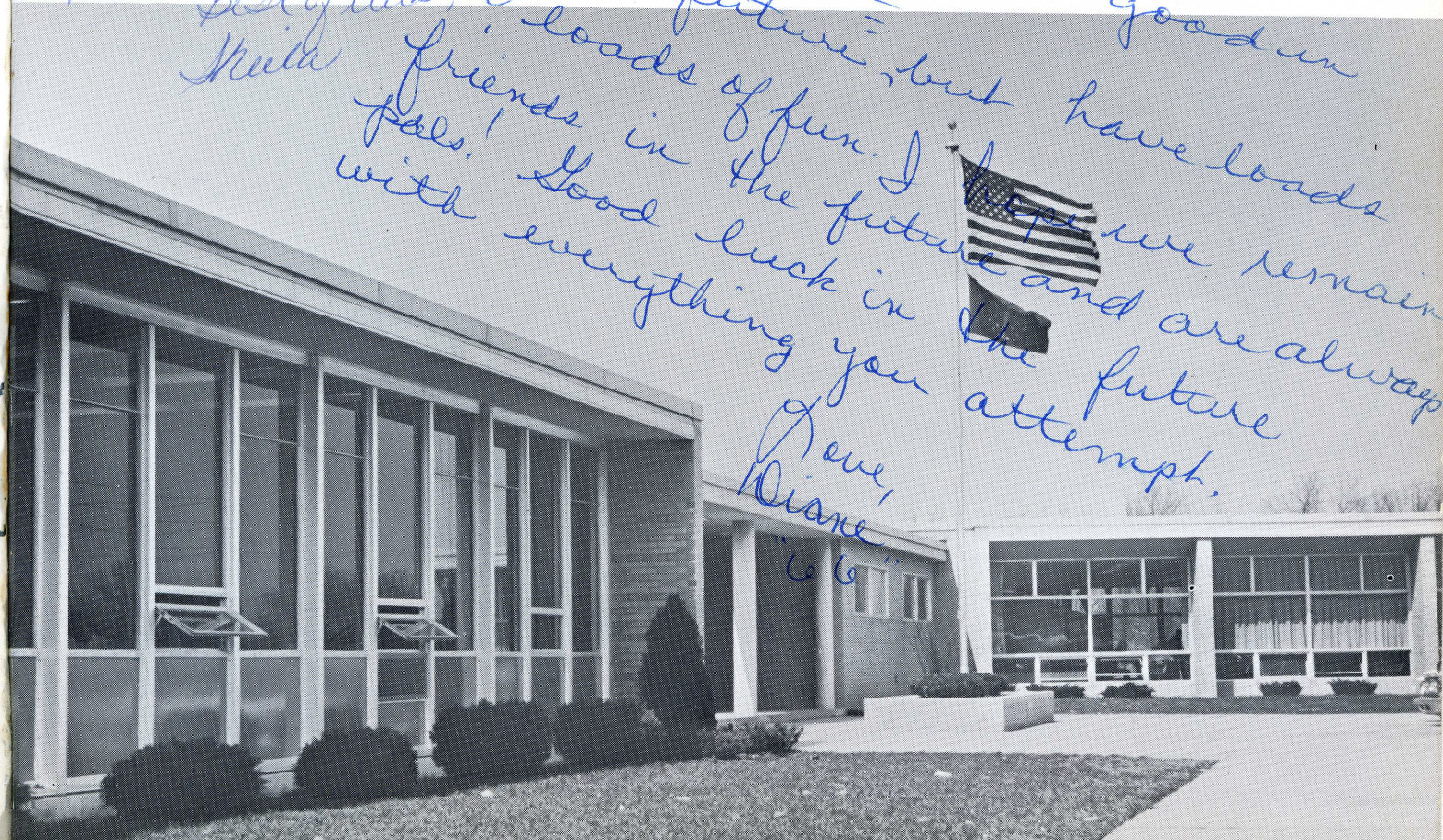

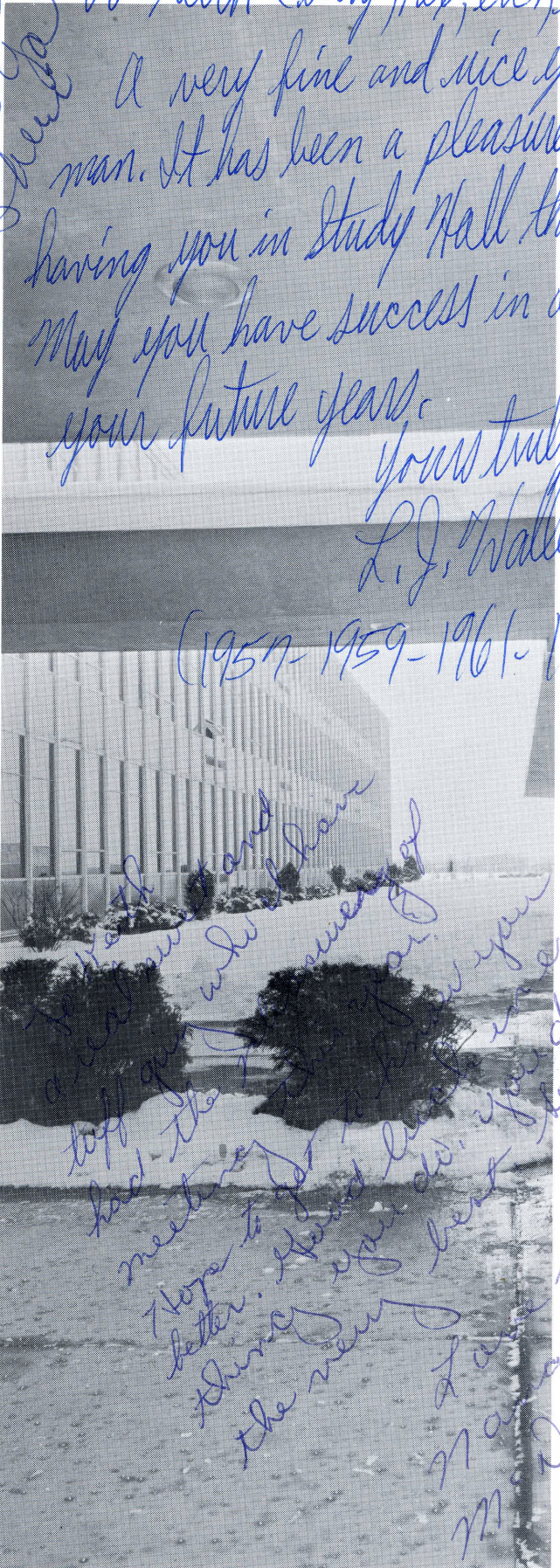


THE CHS SPIRIT...

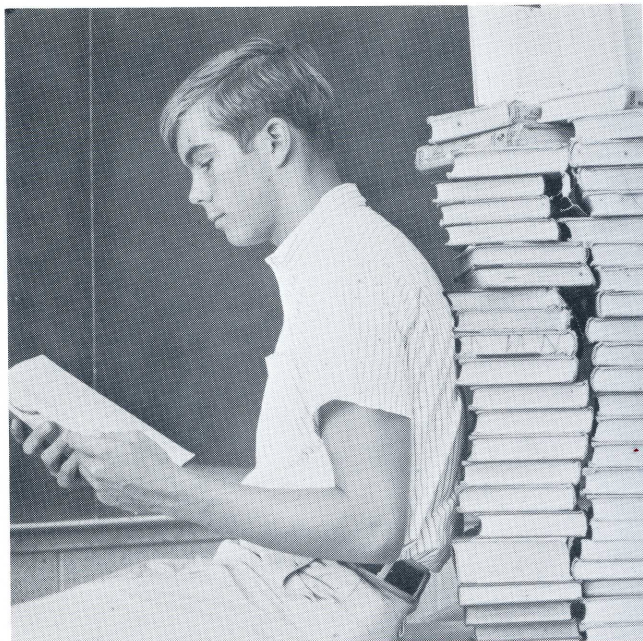

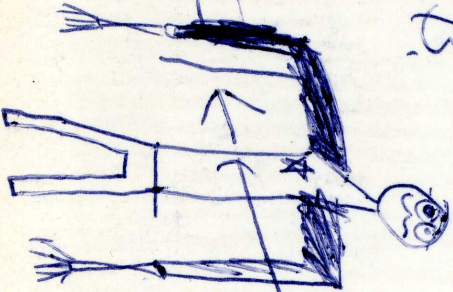
